

CALL HOME TO PARENTS FOR THEM TO PICK THEM UP OR BRING THEIR UNIFORM


WILL BE PLACED IN MS MAHA'S OFFICE UNTIL THE STUDENT IS IN PROPER UNIFORM.







Parents please know that bus transportation will not be available therefore any bus rider students staying must notify their bus driver and Ms. Dina on that Wednesday morning.




