5 REQUEST TO CHANGE AN ELECTIVE

Students have been sent a QR code and link for them to place a request to POSSIBLY change an elective from their schedule.

Once the students have completed the form they are to wait for an email (through their school account ONLY) from our counselor confirming the request or denying the request.

Students are NOT allowed to leave class to ask about their request.

They MUST attend the classes on their Engage schedule until they have been updated.

Changes will close on September 9th.

All schedules will be finalized by September 16th.

Students who have still not come to school after September 9th will not be allowed to make changes.

Student Procedure to Elective Changes

QR Code Process for Elective Changes

- Students interested in changing their elective courses must scan the QR code or access the form through the link below.
- Upon scanning, students should fill out the form indicating the course they want to drop and the course they want to add.
- They should provide a brief reason for the requested change.
- Please do not send the students to the counselor for elective changes; the QR code/ link handles this directly.

Process for Changing AP Courses or Advanced Classes:

- Changes for advanced classes will not be allowed.
- · AP course changes can only be made based on availability.

Important Notes:

- Deadline date to request for a change: 9 September 2024.
- The students will remain in their classes until an official email is sent to notify the teachers and students of any changes.
- Elective changes will only be made after assessing the reason of change and based on availability.
