NAIS Exams Policies, Procedures, and Expectations (MAP – NGRT – Class Exams – AP Exams)

Dear NAIS families

As we approach the final exams period, we would like to remind you of the policies and procedures in place to ensure a fair and smooth examination process. Please review the following guidelines carefully, as they are critical to maintaining academic integrity and discipline.

1. Reporting Medical Conditions

If your child has a medical condition that requires monitoring or special accommodations during exams, please notify the Vice Principal or the Dean of Students in advance via an official email.

This notification must be submitted prior to the start of the exams to allow the school to make the necessary arrangements.

2. Dress Code

All students must wear the full and proper school uniform to be allowed entry into the exam hall. Failure to adhere to the dress code may result in the student being denied access to the exams.

3. Late Arrival to Exams

Students arriving after the exam starts must go directly to the exam room and will not receive any extra time after the end of exam time.

Students arriving extremely late (more than 30 minutes) after the start of the exam will not be allowed to enter the exam room.

It is important to ensure that students arrive on time to avoid any disruptions and ensure they have the full duration to complete their exams.

4. Readiness Expectations and Un-authorized Materials

Students are encouraged to use the washrooms and the school cafeteria for breakfast before the exam starts, to eliminate the distraction during testing.

Students are required to arrive at school fully prepared for testing and must bring all necessary stationery and materials permitted for the exams. Sharing of materials during exams is strictly prohibited.

Students are allowed to have the following items in the testing room:

- Pencil(s) and/or pen(s) - Eraser and/or corrector
- Bottle of water (to be kept on the floor)
- Calculator (if required) - Ruler (if required)

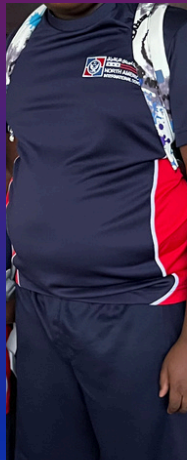

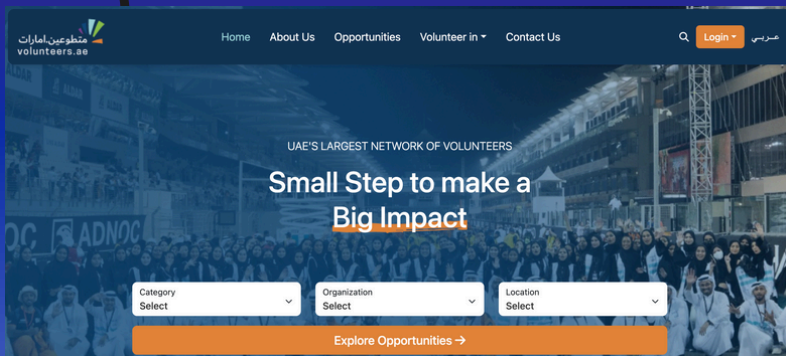
