


In years prior if a student was absent, the parent would have to contact the High School Vice Principal or the High School Dean of Students.





"Late Submission" Policy:


- Unless otherwise specified in class, work will be due on the date given on the class webpage, on the assignment itself, or in the attached calendar.

End of Semester Work Submission:
